

Application for Appointment to Hays County Historical Commission

Members of the Hays County Commissioners Court make appointments for two-year terms and the number of appointees may be limited. Under the Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 318, county commissioners' courts are required to appoint a county historical commission "for the purpose of initiating and conducting programs suggested by the Commissioners Court and the Texas Historical Commission for preservation of the historical heritage of the county." Applications are due in the office of the Hays County Judge no later than January 15, 2017.

Members of the Hays County Historical Commission must be able to attend monthly meetings on a regular basis (usually meets every fourth Thursday) and are expected to take an active role in the activities of the commission by serving on committees, attending HCHC sponsored events, etc.

The purpose of the Hays County Historical Commission is to promote the preservation of our county's historic and cultural resources. Among the activities of the commission are: the placement of official Texas Historical Markers, research on the history of the county, and the promotion of public awareness of the importance of history to the future of the county through publications, oral histories, and documentaries.
